









Carefully release the securing tabs to remove the diffuser.



 Loosen the four screws and turn the LED panel to release. Lift and remove the gear tray assembly.

CARE SHOULD BE TAKEN NOT TO TOUCH THE LEDs.



- A hole can be drilled where appropriate on the backplate or at the entry points to feed the mains supply through.
- Use either the BESA box or surface fixing points to fix the luminaire in place.
